## Making NEGATIVE words

A prefix is when you add letters to the beginning of a word. By doing this, you change the meaning of the word. When you use the prefix of 'un-' or '-dis' the word changes to its opposite meaning, and is usually negative.

### For example:

'happy' becomes 'unhappy'  
'appear' becomes 'disappear'  
'appreciated' becomes 'unappreciated'
